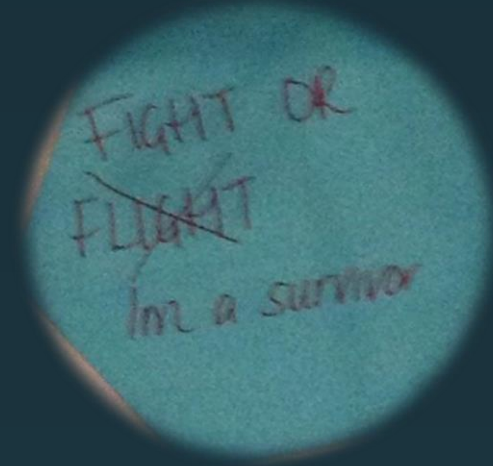
Case Study of a strategy day for the team at Humraaz

# Results

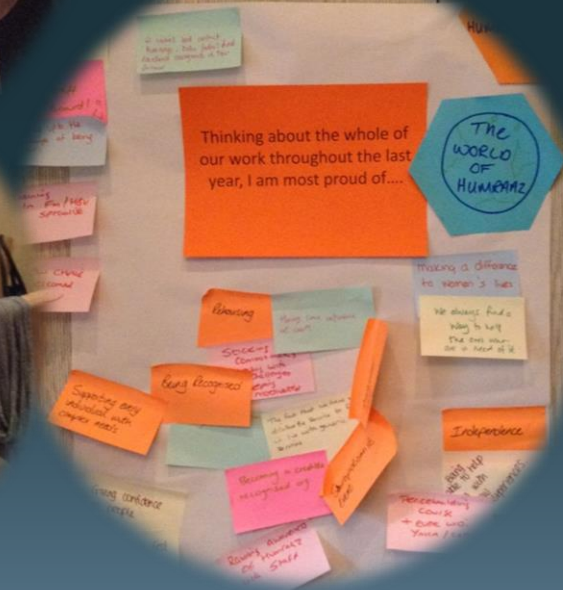
- The team can articulate what Humraaz stands for which will support funding applications
